

# 6 NURSING LICENSE SUSPENSION REASONS



Following are some actions which can result in your license being revoked

Step by Step

## 1 FALSE PATIENT RECORDS

I know you might have distorted the patient's record by mistake but falsifying patient records is harmful for both your license and the patient. Whether you are exhausted or excessively busy, always complete the patient's record to prevent yourself and the patient from unwanted problems.

## 2 NONPROFESSIONAL BEHAVIOR

One of the main reasons for the nurse license revocation is unprofessional behavior with the patients and your colleagues. You must be very cautious when talking with your colleagues and the patients, make sure you never use abusive language in front of anyone.

## 3 INTERRUPTION OF PATIENT PRIVACY

Your patients are trusting you with their treatment and their disease, so remember not to discuss their details with others, not even your fellow nurses, you are only allowed to share their details with the doctor who is appointed to treat them. A nurse must respect the privacy of his/her patient, every information about the patient should be kept confidential, if a nurse fails to do so, his license will be revoked.

## 4 NEGLECTING AND ABUSING PATIENTS

Nurses are highly occupied during their working hours which may cause them not to give proper attention to some patients. Remember, no matter how overloaded with work you are, always give the right amount of attention to your patients. Asking your patients for personal favors and money can also result in suspension of nursing license.

## 5 DIVERTING MEDICATION

It is the stealing of medicines which are prescribed to the individuals. As the nurses have access to different medicines, they may take the medicines for themselves or someone else, some nurses also steal medicines from the hospital to sell the medicines illegally. In both cases the nurse will get his/her license revoked and may end up in jail.

## 6 CRIMINAL RECORD

Whether a nurse is on duty or off duty he/she must stay away from the crimes, if a nurse is found involved in different crimes and illegal actions then this leads directly to suspension of nurse license.
