Step by Step

1 PROFESSIONALISM

4 HONESTY IS THE BEST POLICY

Always stay honest with your profession and do your work in the best way possible. If you make a mistake while treating the patient, directly report to your doctor in charge to avoid worsening the patient's condition. Keeping the right medical record of the patient is also included in honesty towards the profession. Also, if you are uncomfortable with attending certain patients directly inform about it to the in-charge in order to avoid any undesirable consequences.

5 WATCH YOUR SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNTS

Although, there is nothing wrong in making a social media account but, as a nurse ensure that all your social media accounts are private. As everyone is on social media nowadays, watch what you post on your social accounts because what you share with the world influences the way people think about your personality. Make sure you avoid sharing abusive stuff on your social media accounts.

6 COMMUNICATION

Good communication skills are very important in the nursing profession. Communication plays a vital role in medical treatment as nurses have to inform the doctors regarding the patient's condition, breathing rate, heart rate, oxygen saturation and other vital signs. Moreover, not being able to communicate with the physician can also lead to revocation of nursing license.
